A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE AUTHORIZATION OF PHYSICIAN ASSISTED SUICIDE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE SILVER LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The Silver Legislature believes that a
- 2 terminally ill patient's decision-making over the time and means
- 3 of death is a highly personal matter. A terminally ill
- 4 patient's request for the assistance of a physician to
- 5 accelerate death ought to be treated with dignity and respect.
- 6 Therefore, the Silver Legislature finds it appropriate,
- 7 compassionate, and humane to authorize a physician to prescribe
- 8 medication to empower a mentally competent, terminally ill,
- 9 adult patient, who has a full understanding of options and
- 10 consequences, to exercise control over this intensely private
- 11 decision. The purpose of this Act is to authorize physician
- 12 assisted suicide.
- 13 SECTION 2. A terminally ill, competent adult suffering
- 14 from an incurable and irreversible disease that will produce
- 15 death within six months may obtain, upon written request, a
- 16 prescription from a licensed physician for medication of a self-
- 17 administered oral lethal dose.
- 18 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
